




2 Record your own

Observations should document individual organisms. Accompany each with one or more close-up, focused photos.

Observations can be made without internet. Once you have an internet connection, upload your observations

- Use the "Location" field to search for "Malaysia"


You can also zoom/pan the map manually and click 'Redo Search in Map' to create your own bounding box


Click on the tabs to further explore the data
